Sustainable Landscaping Checklist

Dear Landscaper,
I am trying to make my yard healthier and more sustainable. Are you available to provide any (or all) of the following options that I have checked for my yard maintenance?
 Use electric, battery-powered equipment for some or all of the work. ☐ You may use my electrical outlet to recharge your battery. ☐ You may use my battery-powered equipment
Leave grass height at 3" (fall) to 3.5" (spring and summer) height.
☐ Mulch the grass clippings into the lawn.
☐ Use leaf blower only for Spring / Fall cleanup, not in the Summer.
$\hfill \Box$ Use blower for a minimum number of minutes; supplement with rakes or brooms.
☐ Rake some leaves into a pile that I can use later for compost.
☐ Mulch-mow leaves that are on the lawn throughout the fall season. Rake, sweep or blow only on areas with heavy leaf cover such as walkways and driveways.
□ Do not remove all leaves from garden beds. Leave some for butterfly and pollinator over-wintering spots as well as nutrients for garden beds.
□ Do not use synthetic chemicals on my lawn for fertilizing / pest management. Use only my grass clippings, compost or another product that we are able to discuss in advance.
